Core 52, chapter 32

Introduction

- Incarnation – to take on flesh
 - I. God is Near
 - A. This Makes Christianity Unique
 - 1. He is near
 - 2. But He is also a personal God
 - B. This Makes God Knowable
 - 1. When We look at Jesus we see God
 - 2. John 14:8
 - II. God is Love
 - A. He Loves His Enemies – Romans 5:8
 - B. That Love is demonstrated through forgiveness – Luke 23:34
 - III. God Suffered
 - A. He Suffered for Us – Isaiah 53:4-6
 - B. He Suffered with Us
 - IV. Living Incarnationally
 - A. Be Present
 - B. Love Sacrificially
 - C. Join Others in their Suffering
