Sermon: A Shepherd's Heart – Mentorship

Timothy – a young man who benefited from mentorship

- From his mother and grandmother
- From Paul himself

But what is mentorship?

- I. What Mentorship is Not
 - A. Mentorship is not friendship
 - B. Mentorship is not merely teaching
 - C. Mentorship is not an “easy fix” for your life
- II. Mentorship is Coaching – 2 Timothy 2:1-7
 - A. A coach works in gameplans, not blueprints
 - B. A coach knows what motivates his players
 - C. A coach looks through the windshield, not the rear-view mirror
- III. How to be a good mentor
 - A. Focus on your area of expertise (it's okay to have multiple mentors)
 - B. Three illustrations of the benefits of mentorship/discipleship
 1. Military – discipline
 2. Athletics – drive/motivation
 3. Farmer – Work ethic/fruitfulness
- IV. Where are you in the mentorship process?
 - A. You should be either a mentor, seeking a mentor, or learning from a mentor
 - B. This is vital to your personal growth

- Identify one area of your life in which you could be a mentor. Who is someone you can try to coach in this area?
- What keeps people from seeking out mentors? How can you overcome those roadblocks?
